Company & Location:

- **Company:** Located in Stateline, Nevada service the California and Nevada Lake Tahoe Region. This is a family owned business that has been in operation for 42 years. Local families from town and tourist partake in this activity and enjoy taking a ride in a horse drawn carriage and in the winter wonderland on a sleigh ride through the snow and mountains. This is a popular ski resort community and perfect for the student looking for easy access to the slopes on their day off after the initial holiday business slows down in the winter and in the summer it is a resort town with lakes, swimming, hiking, casino's.
- **Location:** Stateline is located on the border of California and Nevada. You will easily find Casino's, restaurants, shopping, Movie Theater and dance clubs all easily accessible on your day off. This area is picturesque with white capped mountains, a beautiful lake and tones of outdoor activities for the adventurous. 3.5 hours from San Francisco and 1 hour from Reno, NV where you will find additional casino's, night clubs and discos.
- **Weather:** Winter is very Cold and Snowy with -10 Celsius or colder.



Job Opportunities:

Team Member—YOU MUST BE COMFORTABLE AROUND ANIMALS AND HORSES AS YOU WILL BE TRAINED TO DRIVE A HORSE PULLED CARRAIGE and SLEIGH.

- Some job responsibilities include: Guide a horse drawn carriage in the summer and sleigh in the winter in the snow and give historic tours and share your knowledge of the town.
- You may be asked to greet guests, sell tickets, take pictures for sale, schedule rides over the phone so you must be able to work in a fast paced environment.
- There are times you will be caring for the horses including feeding, cleaning the stables and any other task assigned. YOU MUST LOVE ANIMALS and be able to work with large horses, be

friendly, outgoing, and stand for long periods of time and in the winter it will be outdoors in the snow. In the summer additional maintenance work such as cutting grass and other ranch activities will be assigned to you. You will work all weekends and holidays.

- **Pay Rate** - \$9.00
- **Work Hours** – 30 – 40 hours per week depending on snowfall
- **Work Shifts** – Must be available to work all shifts and positions seven days per week including Friday & weekends & holidays (9am – 6pm)
- **Job Start Date** – May 1st - Flexible
- **Job End Date** – 5, 10 or 12 (with a month off in October)
- **Experience** – Experience with horses preferred. Must pass interview by webcam with LifExchange staff and final approval with employer

Housing & Transportation:

Housing: \$100-125 per week. 1-2 Participants will live in a shared one bedroom apartment located on the ranch estate. Two weeks rent and \$100 deposit required at arrival for \$350 total. Fully furnished with Internet and utilities included in remote location.
